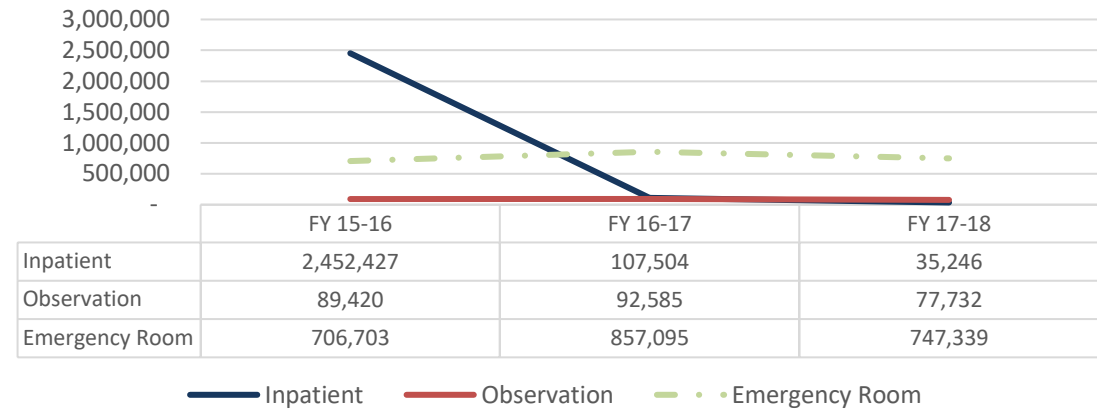

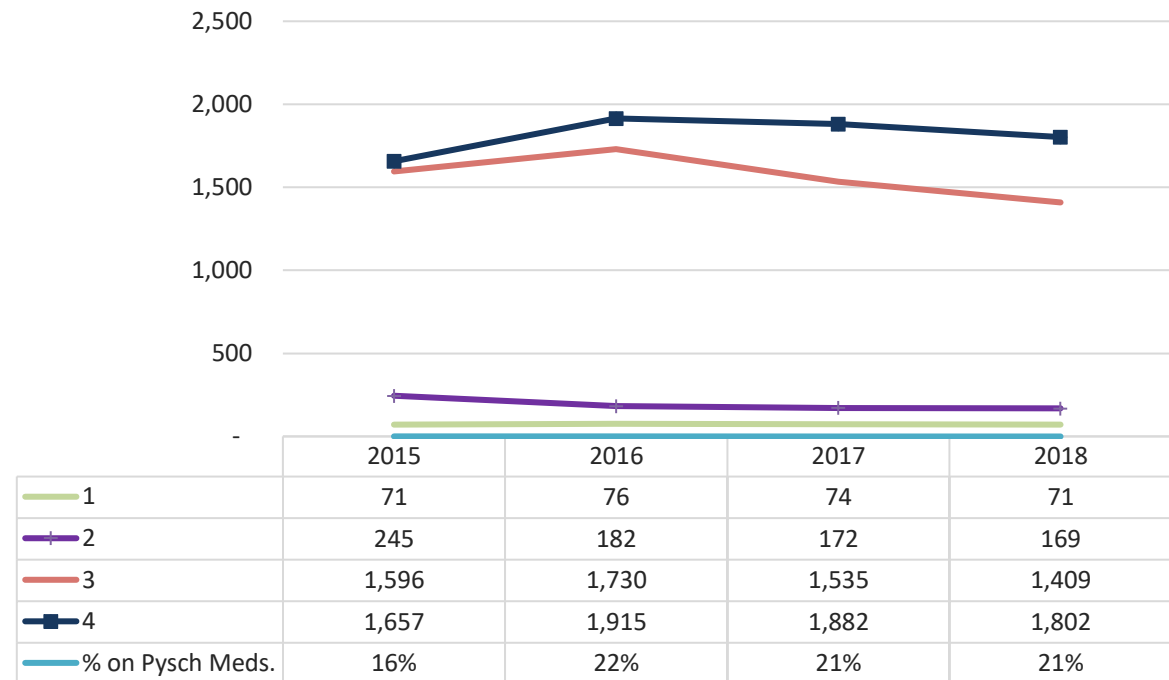

Mental Health Level of Care



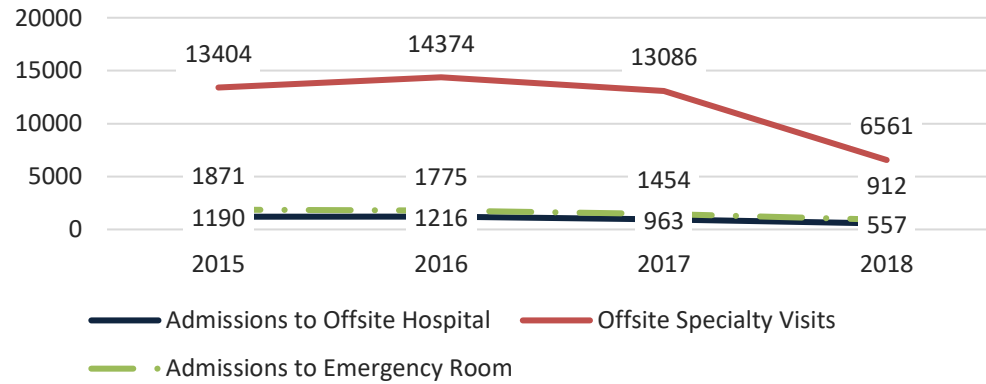
An offender with a Mental Health Level of Care 1-3 is consider to have a serious mental illness (SMI). SMI is defined as a confirmed diagnosis of at least one of the following:

- 1) Major Depressive Disorder (MDD);
- 2) Schizophrenia;
- 3) Schizoaffective Disorder;
- 4) Bipolar Disorder;
- 5) Unspecified Schizophrenia Spectrum; or
- 6) Severe Anxiety Disorder.

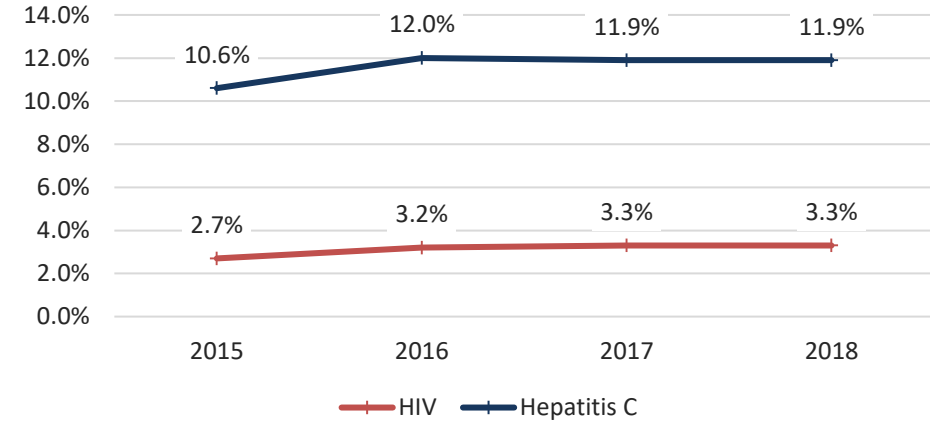
Mental Health Level of Care 4 is assigned to offenders with any diagnostic impression, excluding SMI, addiction disorder diagnosis, or those requiring mental health interventions within the previous 12 months.

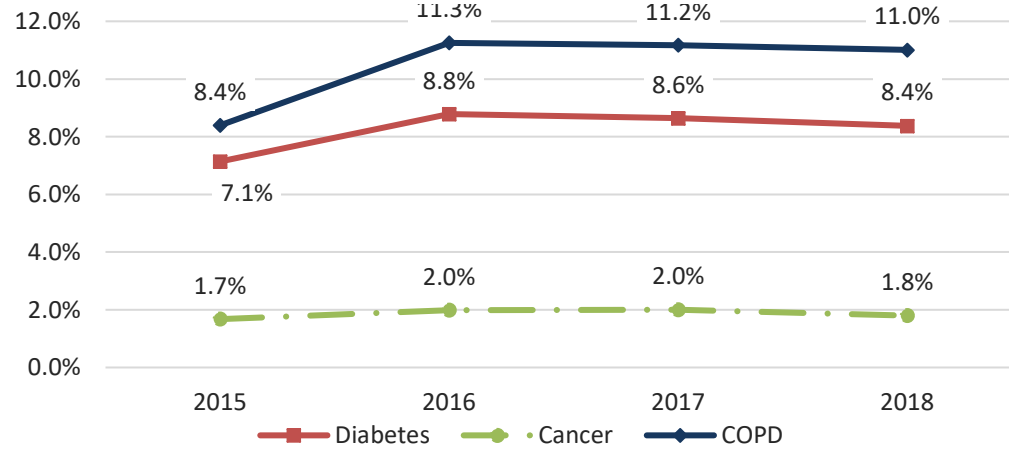

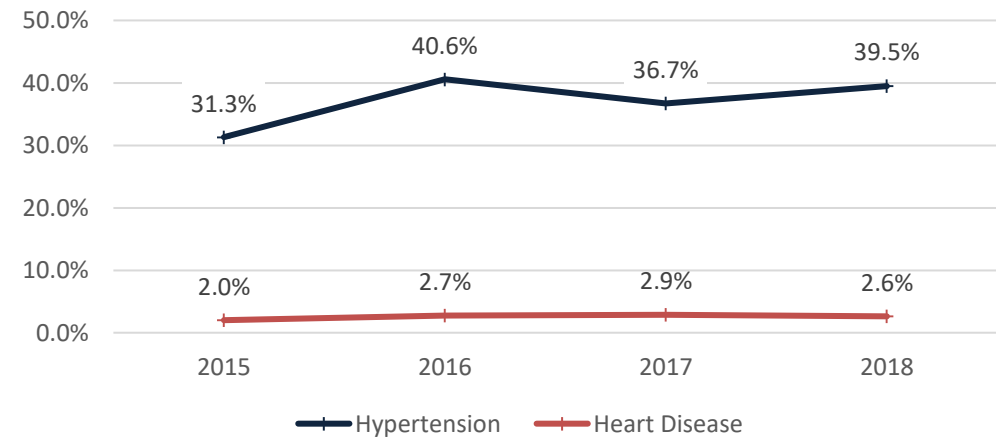

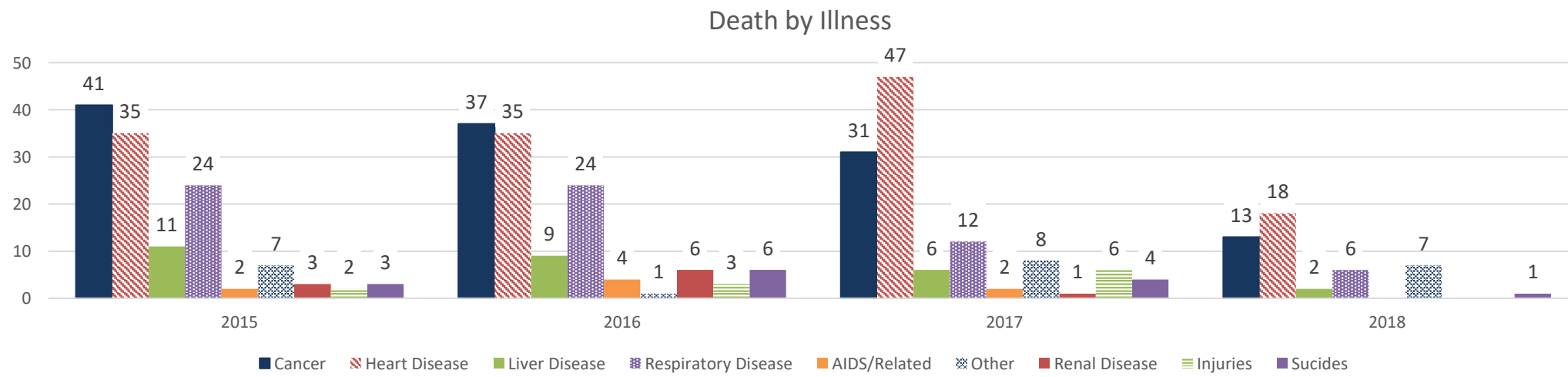
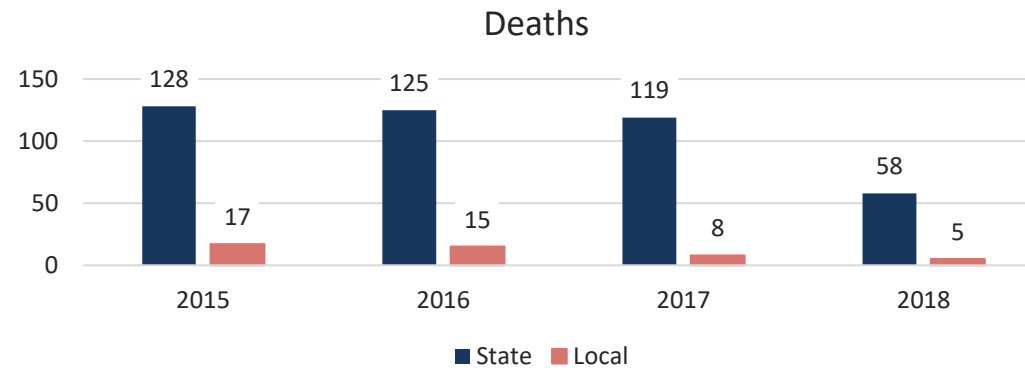
Chronic Diseases (Pt. 1)
